

# Rutherglen Country Fair

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The Rutherglen Country Fair is to be held on Sunday June 12, 2022. The Rutherglen Country Fair is one of the largest regional markets in Victoria, with stalls along Main Street and part of High Street. It is open from 9:00am until 3:30pm and has previously attracted over 6,000 visitors. The fair turns our small town of Rutherglen into a bustling place to be during the Winery Walkabout weekend. Funds raised from this event benefit local community groups.

The stalls at the market include produce, craft stalls, clothing, tools, etc. Hot food stalls are provided by local community groups and local traders.

### Market Conditions

Please read the following conditions that all stallholders must comply with before completing and returning this application form.

- 1 Any **COVID safe** restrictions in place at the time of the market **MUST BE ADHERED TO**. Hand sanitiser should be provided at your stall.
- 2 Stallholders **WILL NOT** be permitted to **sell hot food, beverages or offensive products** (smell, noise etc).
- 3 Power **IS NOT** available and generators **ARE NOT** permitted.
- 4 Public address systems **ARE NOT** permitted.
- 5 Stall set up cannot commence before 7am and must be removed for the road to re-open to traffic by 4:30 pm.
- 6 Stalls will be allocated after the closing date. Those who have previously attended will not be able to request a particular site.
- 7 Stallholders are required to remain within the area allocated and keep their goods within that space. Footpaths must be kept clear for pedestrian traffic. Vehicles cannot remain on your site.
- 8 Stallholders determine the amount of space required (each site = 3m X 3m) and to pay accordingly. Space will be allocated on the basis of \$100.00 per site (maximum of 3 sites) per application.
- 9 Please bring your site notification letter as proof of site number/s on the day.
- 10 The organisers retain the right to reject any application and return any application fee.
- 11 Stallholders must provide proof of their Public Liability Insurance covering the June 12, 2022 upon request.
- 12 Closing date for all applications is **Saturday April 30, 2022**.
- 13 Stallholders are required to leave their site(s) clean, tidy and **FREE OF PACKAGING**. If this is not complied with, any future application may be refused.
- 14 If you change any of your contact details please notify the **MARKET SECRETARY** immediately.
- 15 The Rotary Club makes no provision for, nor takes any responsibility for inclement weather.
- 16 Sites are not transferable.
- 17 ALL FOOD SELLERS must hold a current registration on the online STREATRADER system: <http://www.streatrader.com.au> and must submit their STREATRADER SOT (Statement of Trade) prior to the event allowing time for Indigo Shire to confirm your eligibility.
